Monday is a holiday and the school will be closed. Second semester begins on Tuesday on January 22nd. All students will report directly to advisory for a final copy of their second semester schedules.

Biology, Algebra II, Chemistry, Physical Science, and Physics end-of-course assessments in the fall will be delayed approximately two to three weeks until the standards are set and approved by the State Board of Education. **As a result, students will be assigned an "Incomplete" on their report card until the scores are available.**

Per State Board Policy, the scores must account for twenty-five percent of the student's final grade in the course. **Once end-of-course test scores arrive in these areas, final averages will be tabulated and report card grades will be amended from an incomplete to reflect an actual final grade. New report cards will be printed for the students at this time.**

Yearbook sales will close for the year on January 31. No orders can be accepted after this time. Order forms are available in the main office of both campuses for in school purchases. Books can be also be purchased online through the Wakefield website link.

Schedule change requests for second semester will end on Friday, January 24 at 3pm. Remember, requests may be submitted only through SPAN.
