The PSAT will be administered on October 17th. Ninth and tenth grade students may register for the PSAT in Student Services before and after school or during their lunch. The last day to register is Wednesday, September 26th. The cost is \$13.00 for 9th and 10th grade students. There is no cost for the PSAT for juniors. Juniors are automatically registered therefore do not need to come to Student Services.

Parents and students seeking induction into the National Honor Society are reminded that Student Information Forms are due by 3 PM next Wednesday, Sept 12. To be eligible for membership, a student must fill out and turn in the form. Forms and requirements for membership are located on the WHS website.
