Progress reports were distributed on Friday, December 12. The next few weeks are critical as we wrap up quarter as well as begin review for upcoming final exams.

Does your child need extra help in one of his/her classes? If so, we are here to help. Wakefield North has started a Learning Center where students can receive peer tutoring after school from 2:30-3:30 in room 1408. This service is free and runs each day.

This is a friendly reminder that our office staff cannot accept money from parents to give to your student. We also do not call students out-of-class to come down and get money when a parent brings it.

WCPSS Board Policy states that if a student has an electronic device out in use or if it is visible, then it can be confiscated by a staff member. Any confiscated electronic device must be picked up by a parent or guardian. We cannot make exceptions to this.

If you are coming to pick up your child for an appointment or early dismissal, please be prepared to show some type of photo ID.

Students who miss over 10 days of school can fail a course due to attendance despite the numeric grade. Any student who has missed excessive days can validate their absences at Saturday School, which is held on main campus from 9-12 each Saturday.
